

TOURNAMENT RULES

PLAYING RULES

- The tournament will be run under the control and jurisdiction of the Barclays Bank Tenpin Bowling committee.
- 2. The tournament will be run under the general playing rules of the B.T.B.A. together with the following special rules, which will govern the tournament.
- 3. Each team member must be a member of hers/his National Bowling Association/Federation.
- 4. Each team member must wear a bowling shirt of the same colour with the Bank and Country names on the back. It is suggested that the trousers/skirts have the same colour for each team.

ELIGIBILITY

- 5. The tournament is open to Bank teams of four players representing the same Banking Institution in the same European Country. Each team may have <u>five</u> eligible players but only one player may be changed during a series.
- 6. No person may play in the tournament except those originally entered or such replacements as authorised by the team captain and accepted by the Tournament Management prior to the start of play.
- 7. Each team captain must be in possession of a written confirmation that all the team players are either:
 - a. employees of the respective Bank,
 - b. or retired staff in receipt of a pension from the respective Bank.
- 8. Ladies will have an additional 10 pins per game throughout the competition.

COMPETITION FORMAT

1st Round

9. <u>Saturday</u>: each team will play two series of three games – first series in the morning and the second series in the afternoon.

2nd Round

- 10. <u>Sunday</u>: teams will be divided into two sections based on their finishing position on Saturday to compete in either the Challenge or Plate Sections. The top 16 team will play in the Challenge and the remaining teams will play in the Plate section.
- 11. 50% of the scores rolled on Saturday will be carried forward.
- 12. Challenge Section the teams will be divided into two equal groups (Group A: 1/3/5 ... and Group B: 2/4/6 ...) and will play three games.

Plate Section - the remaining teams be divided into two equal groups (Group C: 17/19/21 ... and Group D: 18/20/22 ...) and will play three games.

3rd Round

13. The top four teams of each group will form two groups composed by four teams: Challenge Section:-

Group 1: Teams 1 and 3 of Group A and Teams 2 and 4 of Group B

Group 2: Teams 2 and 4 of Group A and Teams 1 and 3 of Group B

Plate Section:

Group 3: Teams 1 and 3 of Group C and Teams 2 and 4 of Group D

Group 4: Teams 2 and 4 of Group C and Teams 1 and 3 of Group D

The format will now be a round robin within each group. Each team playing one game against each opponent play a round-robin series, starting from zero score, with a bonus of 60 pins for a win and 30 pins for a tie.

Finals

14. Challenge Section:

The first teams of Group 1 and 2 will play a final game in order to determine the European Inter Bank Ten Pin Bowling Champion. The 2 teams in second place will play a final game to determine the 3rd and 4th position in Challenge section.

Plate Section:

The first teams of Group 3 and 4 will play a final game in order to determine the Plate winner. The 2 teams in second place will play a final game to determine the 3rd and 4th position in Plate section.

Tried Scores

- 15. In Rounds 1, 2 or 3 where two team have the same score then positions will be determined by the difference between the best team game and the worst team game, with the team with the lowest difference taking the higher position.
- 16. In the Finals, positions will be decided by a 9th and 10th frame roll off.

DISPUTES

17. A provisional ball shall be rolled in the case of a dispute which cannot be settled on the spot. Any protests must be made verbally to the Tournament Management at the time and confirmed in writing within 2 hours. The Tournament Committee's decision shall be final.

ENTRY FEES

18. The entry fee of £160. Payable by swift transfer see details below. Entry fee is non-returnable after squad details have been accepted.

TAXIS

SOUTHAMPTON

Is a growing large university city with a history based on the docks, "The Gateway To The World", as British emigrants left from here, and tourists, on the cruise ships starting with the steam liners. It was also the port of departure of the *SS Titanic*.

Every modern shop is here in the town, yet despite rebuilding after the Second World War, it has managed to preserve the medieval walls. From Bargate, with its turrets and museum, there are escorted walking tours. Some nice churches survived the bombing, including St Mary's, 19th century, the Norman St Michael's, and Holy Wood has a 14th century tower. The harbourside is an attractive area, now redeveloped with a marina, cafe's etc.

Places to visit:

Maritime Museum - 14th century warehouse, history of the port and the liners that visited. God's House Tower - 15th century, have a go at a gun battery, now houses displays about the Saxon past of the city.

Hall Of Aviation - old aircraft including helicopters.

Bishop's Waltham Palace - impressive ruins of the Bishop of Winchester's palace, William of Wykeham who founded Winchester College and New College in Oxford, died here, 12th century, suitated on B2177, north of Fareham off the A334, north off Junction 10 east of Southampton on the M27,
