SUNDAY 24 APRIL: Position Games, Round Robin and Final

50% of Saturday's scores will be brought forward to Sunday. The 21 Teams will be divided into Challenge (10) and Plate (11) sections. Each section will play a three game 'Position' series followed by a 'Round Robin' series leading to a one game final.

Position Series

<u>Plate – 09,30</u> Teams finishing from 11^{th} to 21^{th} in Saturday's Preliminaries will be divided into two groups and play a position series of three games. Group C 11,13, 15, 17, 19, 21 and Group D – 12, 14, 16, 18, 20.

<u>Challenge – 09,30</u> - The top 10 teams on Saturday will be divided into two groups of five and play a position series of three games. Group A - 1, 3, 5, 7, 9 and Group B - 2, 4, 6, 8, 10.

Round Robin - 14,00

The top four teams from Group A and B (Challenge) will form two groups of four to play a round robin series. The top four teams from Group C and D (Plate) will also form two groups of four to play a round robin series. Each team plays one game against each opponent with a bonus of 80 pins for a win and 40 pins for a tie.

Challenge:-

Group 1: 1st and 3rd teams from Group A and 2nd and 4th from Group B.

Group 2: 2nd and 4th teams from Group A and 1st and 3rd teams from Group B.

Plate:

Group 3: 1st and 3rd teams from Group C and 2nd and 4th teams from Group D. 2nd and 4th teams from Group C and 1st and 3rd teams from Group D.

Final 17,00

Challenge:

The 1st placed teams in Groups 1 and 2 Round Robin will play a final game in order to determine the European Champion. The 2^{nd} placed teams in each group will play a final game to determine the 3^{rd} and 4^{th} position.

Plate:

The 1st placed team in Groups 3 and 4 Round Robin will play a final game in order to determine the Plate winner. The 2nd placed team in each group will play a final game to determine the 3rd and 4th position in the Plate section.

TEAM POSITIONS AND SCORES

Note: Ladies will have an additional 10 pins per game throughout the competition.

<u>Preliminaries</u> (Saturday) - Team positions will be determined by total pinfall accumulated, including any ladies handicap, *but only 50% of this is carried forward into Sunday's Position Series*. Top 10 go to Challenge; rest to Plate.

<u>Position Series</u> (Sunday) - team positions in each group will be determined by the 50% brought forward from Saturday plus the total pinfall, including any ladies handicap, achieved in this series.

Round Robin (Sunday) - team positions in each group will be determined by the total pinfall, including ladies handicap, and bonus pins achieved.

<u>Tie breaker</u> - In the event of a tie for any position the highest last game of the tied teams will determine the team position except in the final where the $9^{th}/10^{th}$ frame roll off will resolve a tie.

DISPUTES

A provisional ball shall be rolled in the case of a dispute which cannot be settled on the spot. Any protests must be made verbally to the Tournament Management at the time and confirmed in writing within 2 hours. The Tournament Committee's decision shall be final.

AWARDS

<u>Team</u>; The Champions will be awarded the European Challenge Trophy. There will be individual awards for each player competing in the final.

The Plate winners will receive the AIB Perpetual Plate Trophy. There will be individual awards for each player competing in the final.

In addition there will be Team High Game and Team High Series awards based on the 9 games in the Preliminaries and Position Games. A team may receive only one of these team awards.

<u>Individuals</u>: There will be individual awards – both male and female - for High Game, High Average (must have played 50% of the games) and High Series based on the 9 games in the Preliminaries and Position Games. An individual may receive one individual prize only.

BOWLING ATTIRE

Each team member must wear a bowling shirt that has the same colour; the players name on the back of the shirt; the Bank and Country names on the back (may be initials e.g. AIB for Allied Irish Banks) and a breast shield of the Bank.

LANE DRESSING PATTERN

Sintetic lanes and approaches with AMF 82/70 machine and Qubica Scoring. The lanes are oiled to 36 ft. and buffed out to 40 ft. The Oil applied with a Kegel Phoenix Oiling machine. (I calculate 36ft to be about 11m and 40ft to be 12m).

TOURNAMENT MANAGEMENT.

The tournament will be run under the control and jurisdiction of committee will be responsible for the tournament Management.
